AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the AKC. Phone (919) 816-3776.

Entry Blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Jr Showmanship will not be accepted

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who have not won three First Places in a Novice Class.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have not won three First Places in a Novice Class.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show who have not won three First Places in a Novice Class with competition present.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and have won three First Places in a Novice Class with competition present.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three First Places in a Novice Class with competition present.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and have won three First Places in a Novice Class with competition present.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with Competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES COMPETITION

Offered at all four shows.

No additional fee required to enter this competition.

Dogs must be handled through all regular competition by an eligible owner/handler.

Professional handlers and members of their households are not eligible to participate.

Handler assistants and members of their households are not eligible to participate.

Request to participate in this competition must be indicated by checking the Owner-handler eligibility box on the entry blank.

Eligible dogs will be indicated by an asterisk in the catalog and in the judge's book.

Judging of eligible dogs will be done at the conclusion of each Variety.

The Owner-Handler Rough Collie Variety and the Owner-Handler Smooth Collie Variety

Winners will compete for Owner-Handler Best of Breed after regular Best of Breed

SHOW REGULATIONS

Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted, after the entries have closed, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

Make all Checks and Money Orders payable to Collie Club of Western New York, Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. Funds. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. All entries are to be mailed with fees to Lori Carver, Secretary, P O Box 1204, Belchertown, MA 01007. Entries will not be accepted without fees. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Secretary.

An Event Service Fee and a Recording fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

Post Dated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Fees must accompany entries. This club and/or Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent. This club and its Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or the owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which it is not eligible to compete, or for entering the dog twice.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, lame, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or because it has been entered incorrectly, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. There is no refund for duplicate entries. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The Show-giving club is not responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Do not leave dogs in closed vehicles.

The welfare of any exhibitor's/spectator's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor/spectator. It is expressly understood that exhibitors/spectators will exercise control and restraint over their children on the site and surrounding areas. The Show-giving Club is not responsible for theft or damage to vehicles or personal property.

The Specialty Clubs may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Specialty Clubs or any official thereof.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside. The show-giving Club and the Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

All dogs present must be held on leash except when being judged.
Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Secretary advised at once. The Secretary and Show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
