The Kem Sweepstakes is open to all AKC registered Rough & Smooth Collies which are at least 6 months and under 18 months old on the day of the show. All collies shown in the Sweepstakes must be shown in the Regular Classes at the Regular Class entry fee. Collies in the Kem Memorial Sweepstakes must be shown by the owner, or a member of the owner's immediate family, or a member in good standing of Indiana Collie Club or Columbus Collie Club, or a member of the Collie Club of America. Rough and Smooth Collies will be shown in the same classes. Those placing 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th in each class will compete in one class for the final Sweepstakes placements and money. Entry fee is \$25.00.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS – For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS – For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS – For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3)first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS – For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won ten First Places, with competition present, in an Open Class at a licensed or member show. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. 

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: con-formation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

•Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of pure-bred dogs •Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.

•Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.

•The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factor.

•The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.

•The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placement could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.

•The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.

•The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.

•Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not in consistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.

•Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.

•Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those that trade with them.

•Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisal of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.

•Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them

•Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dogs.

•Sportsmen refused to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which their are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, part-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
