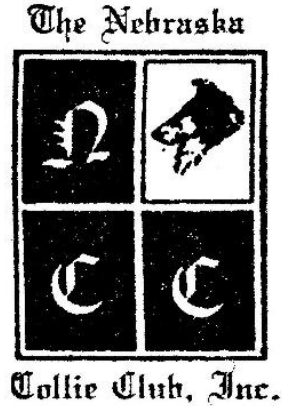

ATTENTION – CHAPTER 17

Section 1. Every dog which is present in the ring for a class in which it is properly entered must continue to compete in all competitions in will its breed or variety for which it is entered or becomes eligible unless it has been excused, dismissed, disqualified or found to be ineligible under the rules. This is an AKC Rule. The Nebraska Collie Club will enforce this rule. All violators be put in the AKC show report.

ROUTES TO SHOW

Directions to Lancaster Event Center (84th and Havelock Ave.)

From the South (Hwy 77) take 77 North to Hwy 2 East. Take Hwy 2 East to 70th St/ Take 70th Street north to O Street. Turn east on O Street to 84th Street. Turn north on 84th Street and follow to the Lancaster Event Center. If travelling from the southeast on Hwy 2 West, take 70th Street and turn north onto O Street. Turn east onto O street to 84th Street. Turn north onto 84th Street and follow to the Lancaster Event Center. From the north (Hwy 77, take I-80 West to the Waverly Exit and follow directions for East/West).

The AM and PM BOB winners will be eligible to compete for Most Versatile Trophy.

The trophy will be awarded to the BOB winner with the most points awarded for Titles, as calculated for Collie Club of America Versatility Award. To recognize the breadth of activities owners can participate in with their dogs, titles achieved that are not included under CCA Versatility schedule will also be awarded ½ point for the highest title of each. For example, a dog that has earned through CGCU will be awarded ½ point for achieving the highest level of the CGC family of titles. See link below for list of CCA Versatility titles and points awarded. Points will be counted for titles entered into the AKC register at the time of show closing at 6pm CST September 20th 2023. In the event of a tie, the tie-breaker will be health testing submitted for each BIS to reward stewardship of our wonderful breed. If there is a tie in both performance titles and health testing for both winners, a special committee will determine a winner.

Second place winner will receive a prize from the Nebraska Collie Club for participating.

Any regular class, Veteran or Champion collie that is entered and shows and is eligible for BOV may be eligible to for this special award. No additional entry is needed.

Dogs must be ready for judging. The Club and its Management will not be responsible and are not obliged to furnish any services for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up classes. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

The Show-giving club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

Requests for refunds for entry fees must be made in writing before the close of show at 6pm CST on September 20th, 2023. Requests may be submitted to Helen Desilet at 3947 W Street Omaha, NE 68107 or by email at nebraskacolliclub@gmail.com.

If, because of Riots, Civil Disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

A Recording Fee of .50 cents & \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee, will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show giving Club and sent to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (*American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 26, Section 2*)

Effective for all shows held ON OR AFTER July 1, 1980, dog which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Changes, Additions, or Corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

The show site will be available to exhibitors as follows: The Lancaster Event Center will be available to exhibitors after 6:00am Friday morning October 6th, 2023. Depending on the schedule of the other paid activities at the auditorium. This policy will be strictly enforced. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT PROOF OF RABIES VACCINATION BE IN THE POSSESSION OF EXHIBITORS OR HANDLERS FOR ALL DOGS AT THESE SHOWS.

No vehicles allowed in the building – Loading & Unloading will be restricted to labeled entrances.

Absolutely NO dogs allowed in the restrooms – There is no roping off of areas, ropes will be removed.

No Un-entered dogs allowed in the building – All parking is on a first-come basis. – The arena coordinator reserves the right to make decisions concerning the grooming/crating/ex-pen areas. – Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions around their grooming and crating areas.

Every attempt will be made to keep the show site and all exhibitors' possessions secure, however the show giving clubs, their officials, members, or agents are not responsible for any loss or damage to equipment or animals left in the auditorium at any time.

Exhibitors should be aware of recently reported attempts by animal rights groups to open crates and release dogs at dog shows. Dogs should not be left unattended at any time.

Crating and grooming allowed in designated areas only. Public exercise pens will be available. The public address system will be used at the discretion of the show giving clubs. Exhibitors are responsible for having their dogs at ringside for judging.

Dogs and/or equipment may be left at the owner's risk in the show site the nights of Friday, October 6 through Saturday October 7 2023, after which time no person except security guards hired by the show giving clubs or by the City of Lincoln, authorized officials of the show giving clubs, and their employees of the Lancaster Event Center will be allowed to be in the Area. Any dogs left overnight must have exhibitor names and phone numbers clearly displayed at the crating area should the exhibitors need to be contacted.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
