MAKE ALL ENTRY FEE CHECKS PAYABLE TO NTCC

Entry Fees: \$26 USD for all Regular & Non-Regular Classes.

Catalogs will be \$5.00 and will be exact change only at the show.

For overnight entries: Please contact the Show Secretary. Acknowledgement of entries will be e-mailed as soon as practical after the closing date. Please include an e-mail on the Official Entry Form if you agree to receive entry confirmation by e-mail. All others will be mailed.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Central Oklahoma Collie Club and the North Texas Collie Club will add a collection fee of \$35.00 to the amount of each returned check. All returned checks to be collected at the show will be on a cash basis only and will include the added \$35.00 collection fee.

The Collie Clubs may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim and/or recourse against the clubs or any official thereof.

Entries must be made on an official AKC form or photocopy with the agreement and rules on the reverse side and signed or they cannot be accepted. Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telegraph or telephone entries cannot be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation after the published closing date, nor in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge, veterinarian or barred from competition by the show committee. Entry fees will not be refunded because of weather, riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other act beyond the control of the club management, if it is impossible to open or complete the show.

The COCC/NTCC may for the health and safety of dogs, judges and exhibitors cancel the show in the event of extreme weather conditions, per AKC memorandum dated 7/28/95. In such event, no refund of entry fees will be made.

The show site will be available between 7pm –10pm on Friday, January 28, 2022. Building will re-open on, Saturday & Sunday at 7:00 am. Building will be locked on Friday and Saturday night at 10pm. **DOGS MAY REMAIN IN BUILDING OVERNIGHT.** The COCC and the NTCC are not responsible for any personal property or dogs left in building.

PLEASE NOTE: THERE WILL NOT BE A SECURITY GUARD.

BEST OF VARIETY - Dogs which, according to the owner's records, have completed the requirement for a Championship after the closing of entries, but whose Championship is unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Variety competition, provided the transfer is made to the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of conformation judging at the show.

The COCC and NTCC will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any property, persons or dogs, on or off the show grounds, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is to be distinctly understood by all exhibitors that their dogs and children are their responsibility and are to be in their custody and care at all times. The Collie Clubs assume no responsibility for injury to children, person or dogs.

COVID Guidelines

Due to increases in COVID-19, the show committee has established the following guidelines. As status of the virus changes, these may be adjusted per local, state and/or federal recommendations. Our updated guidelines will be included with entry confirmation and will be posted on the show grounds. By entering or attending this show, you understand the risks associated with communicable disease and accept those risks. Masks covering mouth and nose will be required by all individuals older than 5 years of age while indoors at this event. Bandannas are not appropriate coverings. The show committee will be actively monitoring the show site for mask compliance. Those not willing to comply will be asked to leave or a show committee hearing will be called. Exceptions: 1. The mask requirement while in the conformation ring will be at the judge's discretion. 2. If Covid outbreak improves and/or CDC guidelines change, mask requirements may relax for individuals who choose to show proof of full vaccination and photo ID. 3. Masks are not required while actively eating in your grooming or crating area. This is not snacking all day while grooming. The show committee does not want to police this. Please help each other to remember to correctly wear your mask so we can protect all our friends.
